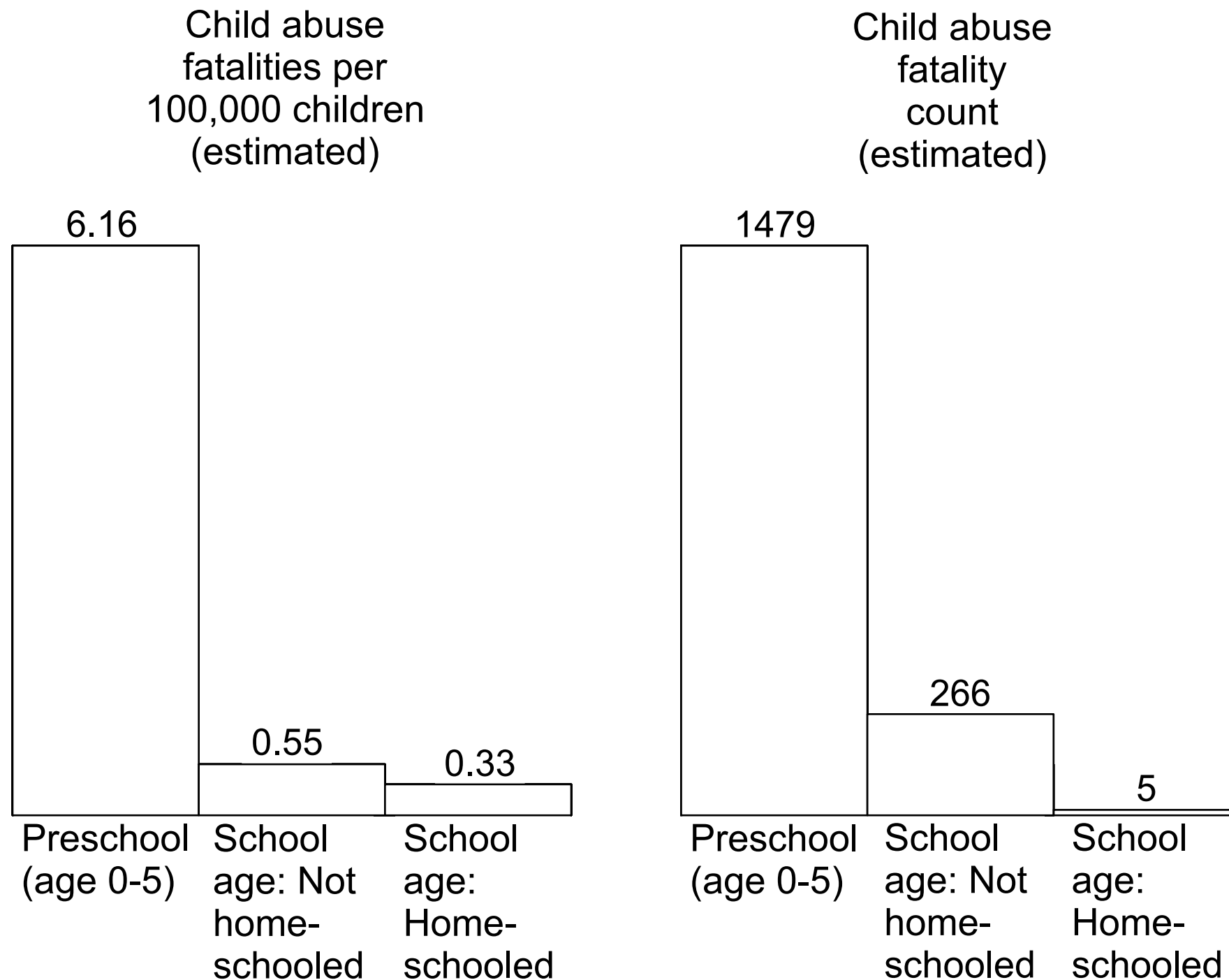


# Child Abuse and Neglect Fatalities 2016



Homeschoolers have both a lower fatality rate and a lower fatality count than either of the other two groups.

Any proposal to address child abuse fatalities which focuses solely on homeschoolers — without proportionately addressing the greater problems in the other groups — is clearly not about preventing fatalities.

Such proposals discriminate against homeschoolers.
